

Phone and Technology Assistance

Lifeline Telephone Assistance

Lifeline provides free or low-cost phone services for households with low income. You may choose either of the following: Lifeline landline service OR wireless service and a free cell phone. **Only one participant allowed per household.**

- Eligibility you may be eligible if you receive any of these benefits:
 - SNAP
 - MassHealth (Medicaid)
 - Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
 - Federal Housing/Section 8 Assistance
 - Veteran's Pension
 - Survivor's Pension
 - OR your total household income is at or below 135% of the poverty guidelines (For current guidelines see: https://www.lifelinesupport.org/do-i-qualify/)
 - You must also have a valid U.S. postal address.
 - One participant per household.
- Benefits you may choose wireless service and a free cell phone OR landline service
 - Wireless Service (Cell Phone) Programs: contact individual programs below to learn about plan details. Apply online through the company of your choice.
