**Thanksgiving meal program**: Once they are a food pantry client, they automatically get signed up for the Thanksgiving assistance program. There is no deadline but it's preferred to not wait until the last minute. The documents required to become a participant are listed below.

Visiting the Food Pantry for the first time? Please bring:

- Proof of residence in one of the communities we serve: **Braintree**, **Cohasset**, **Hingham**, **Holbrook**, **Hull**, **Milton**, **Quincy**, **Randolph**, **Scituate or Weymouth**.
- This could be a current utility bill sent to the head of household, a lease, or other document proving residency.

A form of identification for each person in the household. Examples: driver's license, passport, Massachusetts ID, lease agreement or health insurance card. For children in the household, a birth certificate or Massachusetts health card may be used for identification.

Please note that there is just one order per household. If several adults live in your home, please list them all on your application.
